The Board of Appeals will hold a hearing in December, to consider Hayes family appeal of Zoning Administrator determination that existing parking at Hayes property at Kern and Brompton is not a "legal non-conforming use," and could not be approved as an improved, interim Public Parking lot. Board members discussed this question, and concerns that the site should be developed for housing sooner rather than later.
