4. Sandra Zuniga of the SF Fix-It Team

Zuniga is working to get free solar-powered lights to people to improve nightime safety in thee neighborhood.

Patty Haves

Worked with former Supervisor Jeff Sheehy to change city legislation to allow her family to keep the parking lot as a parking lot. Now they can fix it up and charge for parking. Work should start in a couple of months. It will have somewhere between 19 and 22 spaces.

The city legislation has a six-year sunset clause. After that, they could develop the lot.

6. BART Director Bevan Dufty

BART is trying to work with the merchants association to make the BART property on Wilder into a community garden, at least temporarily.

The oft-discussed planters inside of BART remain a challenge, but the outdoor planters are an opportunity for the community and the agency to work together.

7. Newly elected District 8 Supervisor Rafael Mandelman
