Update local crimes:

Killing of 94-year-old man Leo Hainzl in Glen Canyon Park. Suspect was immediately apprehended. His preliminary hearing was postponed today

Fireworks enforcement

Ideas to improve enforcement next year include education (how to report incidents), increase penalties for violations, earlier outreach to community to gather intelligence to find distributors

3. San Francisco Police Department Chief of Police William Scott

Several officer-involved shootings in 2015, which sparked the efforts to reform.

Eliminated choke-hold, prohibiting shooting at moving vehicles

Seen a reduction of almost 50 percent in use of force incidents. They also categorize pointing a weapon as a use of force incident, that has dropped 60 percent.

Structured department to sustain reforms

4. District 8 Supervisor Rafael Mandelman

\$1.2 billion deficit to close over two years and though our annual budget is \$12 billion, most of that money is mandated to certain expenditures. Everyone will take cuts.

Opportunity to shift funds from the police department to crisis intervention fund.

We have a shortage of beds, we do not have effective case management

City has yet to bring a single conservatorship petition

We keep people in jail who should be in a locked mental health facility instead

He will prioritize finding additional resources for locked and unlocked beds we need to take care of people who need help
