Amos is known for his line drawing style and his murals are adored around The City

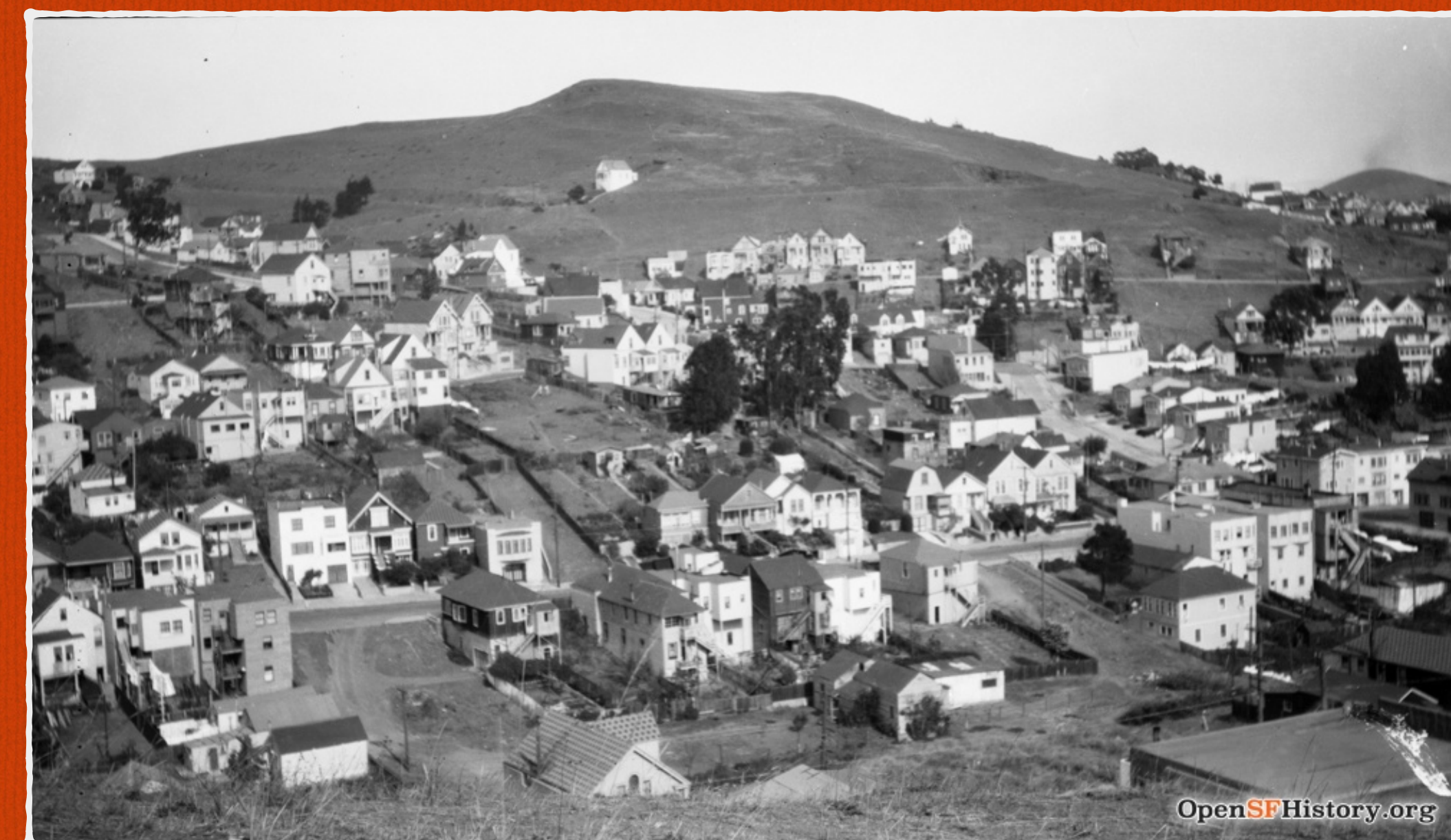

Precedent

Back in 2017, Pinhole Coffee Shop raised funds for their mural using Indiegogo (indiegogo.com)

Process

- ☐ Find the property - **DONE** - 2852 Diamond St. on the side of Pebbles Cafe. Hayes family is allowing for the mural on their building
- ☐ Find the artist - **DONE** - Amos Goldbaum (amosgoldbaum.com)
- ☐ Get buy-in from the community - **IN PROCESS** - At Glen Park Festival I got 43 signatures of neighbors who supported the idea of having Amos do a line drawing mural in Glen Park. At the time I was trying for Buddies Market but ran into a road block with contacting the owner. Now I'd like to reach out to Glen Park residents through the online neighborhood paper and group.
- ☐ Fund the project - **IN PROCESS** - I plan to fund the majority of the project, but it will likely cost \$7,500 and I'd like to get community participation. Likely through Indiegogo.
- ☐ Execution - **TO COME** - Amos is ready to go once I have the funds. I'm hoping to get the project started in April or May.
