Board Meeting Minutes

- Discussion of structure and content of meeting minutes.

Dorothy Erskine Park/ Fallen Trees - Update (Octavio Di Sciullo)

- Recent storms with heavy winds resulted in more tree damage to Bosworth homes. Priorities are removing fallen trees and examining all trees in Dorothy Erskine Park.
- Shout out to local journalism: The GPA Article written by Bonnee Waldstein was picked up by the San Francisco Standard. After publication, the insurance company for one of the houses on Bosworth reviewed the claim and increased the payment.

Chenery Slow Street & Elk / Sussex crosswalk (Scott Stawicki)

- The Elk Street crosswalk has been completed, but vehicles are scraping the roadway going up the hill.
