Board Meeting Minutes

- Approval of April and May meeting minutes. Heather moved to approve, Adrienne seconded. With one abstention, minutes were approved.

July Quarterly Meeting - July 27, 2023

- Meeting will be in person from 6 PM to 8 PM at the Rec Center, with set up at 5:30 PM.
- Potential agenda was discussed.

Discord App (Cory Malnarick)

- Cory gave an overview of Discord, a free app built for groups who want to communicate with each other. He suggested that it be used for GPA outreach. After discussion, Cory agreed to do a trial on his block of Mizpah and report back to the board.

Burnside Tiles (Renee Berger)

- Payment has been received for 100 tiles so far. All 200 tiles were pledged by June 1, and there is a waiting list. The GPA is buying a \$500 tile. The artist will begin fabrication in October 2023, and installation is targeted for Q2 2024.

New Board Member, Kevin Berkemeyer

- The board welcomed our Kevin Berkemeyer as our new Health and Environment chair.

Committee Reports

- Membership: 273
- Treasurer (Dennis): Cash balance at B of A is \$25,655.57 as of 6/12/23
- Greenway (Nicholas): The Greenway is getting 18-20 volunteers each month. They want to complete the last 300 - 400 ft of the trail surface and are applying for add back financing.
 - Board of Supervisors Public Comment Day is June 26. Nicholas is requesting a letter of support for funding to complete the trail.
 - Adrienne moved that we send a letter of support to the board of supervisors. Kevin seconded. MSA
 - Consent from property owners along the path , PUC and the Archdiocese of SF, is also needed.
- Zoning and Planning (Stephany): SF Rent Board is asking for information and fees from all property owners. Carolyn D. will invite the Rent Board to present the program at the quarterly meeting.
